Here are the instructions:

Answer **TWO** questions in all, **ONE** from Section A and **ONE** from Section B.

In each answer, you should refer closely to the play in question.

The exam is divided into two sections with three questions in each.

Section A is devoted to Henry V.

Section B is devoted to The Merchant of Venice.

I would suggest that the best way to revise would be to consult the discussion questions which I circulate in the last of the three weeks devoted to each play. These can obviously serve as revision aids because they highlight the main areas of the play (e.g. characterisation, themes, etc.) which we discussed. Of course, each section of the exam will test you on only three of the discussion topics identified.
